- RCAS district policies apply to summer school just as they do during the school year.
- Teachers will also have their individual expectations.
- Failure to follow these expectations will result in disciplinary action as set forth by the district's discipline matrix.
- Attendance will be determined by a combination of in-person attendance and educational progress.

Who May Enroll

Classes are open to all students grades 9-12 who have **failed core classes or did not complete a distance learning class** and are enrolled in the Rapid City Area Schools.

Grade Level

The grade level just completed in May of 2022 is the grade level to use when registering for classes.

Special Education and IEP modifications are not available in this program.

There is NO tuition cost this year.

Students may take up to **(1) one credit** course during summer school.

Enrollment Requirements

- Students in grades 9-12 may register for classes with their school counselor's approval.
- See your school counselor before the last day of school.

Enrollment is limited and priority will be given in the following order:

- 1) **Seniors** needing credits to graduate this year.
- 2) **Juniors** needing to repeat courses before entering their senior year.
- 3) **Sophomores** who want to retake a class they failed.
- 4) **Freshmen** for the 2021-2022 school year who did not pass a core class.

*Students who have started an Edgenuity course will be allowed to continue that course into this Summer School session, but it will need to be complete by July 14th.

Attendance Policy

- Students in **grades 9-12** may register for classes online.
- Students must make educational progress by completing the required work; failure to engage will result in a failing grade and credit not being given.
- **Students will be required to be in-person the first week of school and if they are on track, may be permitted to work from home.**

Seniors

- Seniors **ONLY** will be provided the option to earn additional credits upon completion of their first full credit, but any additional credits **MUST** be completed by July 14th.
- **ONLY** Seniors who need an initial (first time) credit to fulfill their graduation requirements will be offered this option.
- Seniors are encouraged to contact their counselor and/or administrator for additional guidance.
