

ADVANCED PHOTOGRAPHY

Course Description:

After successfully completing Beginning Photography, expand your photography skills with advanced camera operation, digital editing, and printing techniques. Experience digital publishand photojournalism in conjunction with the school yearbook and newspaper. Develop your creative and critical thought with a mature artistic direction and personal photographic style.

Attendance: Students are required to be in school every day. Students are responsible for communicating with their teachers to make up missed learning.

MAKE UP WORK: To be done during the designated time of 7:30-8:10 am.

Essential Skills:

- 1. Create and Evaluate photographs for effective composition
- 2. Use and Evaluate photographic techniques
- 3. Analyze how the combination of camera settings and desired aesthetics influence the creation of a photograph
- 4. Explore opportunities in commercial photography
- 5. Create commercial photographic products
- 6. Exhibit legal and ethical conduct
- 7. Apply professional aesthetics to compositional elements in photographs
- 8. Demonstrate advanced proficiency in digital darkroom software
- 9. Demonstrate proficiency in using advanced lighting techniques
- 10. Demonstrate use of evaluation techniques for professional portfolios

<u>Course Expectations:</u> Although not everything is graded, everything is important. In order to demonstrate growth and learning, students will need to:

Participate in class activities (take notes, work in a group, complete in class tasks, ask questions) without distractions (cell phones, games, etc.)
Use morning time and the teacher to seek help outside of class when needed.
Complete all assessments within teacher timelines.
