Course Description

Required every year of high school at RCHS, Advisory teaches students specific skills to improve their self-regulation, habits of success, self-efficacy, and college/career readiness.

Course Learning Outcomes

The learner articulates and embodies our school-wide expectations.
The learner defines Advisory and can explain why it is beneficial.
The learner demonstrates growth in 6 or more of the Learner Agency categories.

Classroom Expectations

Advisees are expected to...

- **Be Present**
 - Attend Advisory every day unless excused by guardian and RCHS administration
 - Make academic progress every day
 - Meet with their advisor regularly one-on-one on an as-needed basis

- **Be Respectful & Be Courageous**
 - Advocate for their learning needs and interests
 - Set personal and academic goals with their advisor
 - Monitor their own attendance, academic progress, and missing assignments
 - Obtain assignments before a known excused absence

Grading

Advisory is a Pass / Fail course worth .25 credit for the year. Learners are expected to complete all coursework as assigned by their advisor either on Canvas or on paper.

Textbook

There is no textbook for Advisory. Learners will be expected to complete their “Advisory Journal” where they will track their progress, attendance, credit attainment, and complete some assignments.
