Course Description: Sing all varieties of choral music from different styles, cultures, and languages. Music reading skills and music appreciation will be included while students prepare for several concert performances.

- 3. Complete all assessments within teacher timelines.
- 4. Be present in class and bring their materials daily.
- 5. Perform in final concerts- dates provided on calendar.
