Course Description: Leadership Education and Training (LET) 4 - Managing Leader provides Cadets multiple opportunities to manage and lead in the battalion, in the school, and their respective communities. The LET 4 Cadet is ready to assume responsibilities and manage him or herself and others whom they work with or oversee as a Cadet manager. There are 12 active-learning lessons within five chapters. The chapters are: Leadership, Personal Growth, Team Building, Service Learning, and Citizenship and Government.

Attendance: Students are required to be in school every day. Students are responsible for communicating with their teachers to make up missed learning.

Essential Skills:

1. Provide mentorship to junior cadets and acquire feedback
2. Identify and incorporate personal management and accountability strategies
3. Manage the battalion service-learning project
4. Identify the fundamental challenges to the principles of society; develop solutions to the challenges of citizen rights

Course Expectations: Although not everything is graded, everything is important. In order to demonstrate growth and learning, students will need to:

1. Participate in class activities (take notes, work in a group, complete in class tasks, ask questions) without distractions (cell phones, games, etc.)
2. Use morning time and the teacher to seek help outside of class when needed.
3. Complete all assessments within teacher timelines.
4. Wear appropriate attire on prescribed physical training days (running shoes, sports undergarments, athletic attire).
5. Follow prescribed grooming and hygiene standards for wear of the cadet service uniform during inspections.

Grading

Learning (Practice) includes instructional activities in and outside of class and are not used in grade determination.

Skyward Assessment (Grades) may include quizzes, labs, learning checks, tests, speeches, performances, and projects.
