

# **English 9**

**Course Description:** English 9 is a year-long course satisfying the ninth-grade English requirement. This course includes all standards in the ninth-grade reading, writing, and speaking / listening & language strands in an integrated approach. English 9 is required for all ninth-grade students. A research paper is required.

**Attendance:** Students are required to be in school every day. Students are responsible for communicating with their teachers to make up for missed learning.

**Essential Skills:** Writing, Speaking/Listening, Reading

<u>Course Expectations:</u> Although not everything is graded, everything is important. In order to demonstrate growth and learning, students will need to:

- 1. Participate in class activities (take notes, work in a group, complete in class tasks, ask questions) without distractions (cell phones, games, etc.)
- 2. Use morning time and the teacher to seek help outside of class when needed.
