Farm to School Grant Application

Each year, \$5 million is provided to the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) to support grants, technical assistance, and other activities related to USDA's Farm to School Program. The Farm to School Grant contains multiple grant track options (Implementation, State Agency, and Turnkey) to support various projects and implementation stages; award amounts vary by grant track. Turnkey grant awards will range to \$50,000 with no minimum award amount. RCAS Student Nutrition intends to apply for \$50,000 to continue expanding farm-to-school practices (i.e., hydroponic growing systems, access to local produce, etc.). The Patrick Leahy Farm to School Grant Program is designed to increase the availability of local foods in schools and help connect students to their food sources through education, taste tests, school gardens, field trips, and local food sourcing for school meals. RCAS Student Nutrition has begun implementing farm-to-school practices and strives to continue. The Farm to School Grant will support these efforts.
