To begin the FAFSA: go to Studentaid.gov. Click on “Create an Account” to establish a FSA ID for both the student and parent. Then, click on “Complete the FAFSA form” under “Apply for Aid” on the top menu. You will need Social Security numbers, drivers’ license numbers, 2021 federal income tax returns and W-2s, and records of cash, savings, checking accounts, investments, and assets. Students also need to have their list of schools, colleges, or universities.
