College Action Day—November 2

Seniors will have an opportunity Nov. 2 to receive information & support for their post-high plan.

- November 2: College Action Day! All seniors will use their English period in the library to talk with military representatives or Department of Labor representatives, research scholarships, or apply to college (BOR universities and technical colleges). SD application fees are being waived for BOR universities and technical colleges (and some private schools) until Nov. 30th. Seniors that do not have a SHS English course in their schedule may attend any period except period 3 (there are no English classes that period).

Events at Conferences on November 15

- FAFSA 1:1 Completion event from 5:00-7:00 pm in the Library. You can sit with a Financial Aid Representative and complete your FAFSA. Participation also grants you a free ticket for food at the Black Hills Brick Oven Pizza Truck on campus that evening. SDSMT is sponsoring this event. Please bring parent and student social security numbers and driver's license numbers, student and parent 2021 federal income tax returns and W-2's or income earned from work, student and parent records of untaxed income, student and parent records of cash, savings and checking accounts, investments, and assets, and also a list of the schools, colleges, or universities the student is interested in attending. All financial information will remain confidential.

Prior to coming for 1:1 help, you should set up your StudentAid.gov account by creating your FSA ID for both parent and student. Go to Student.Aid.gov and then click "Create Account."

Seniors - Applying to College

Seniors, if you're applying to college (including Technical Colleges) be aware deadlines may be sooner than anticipated. Research deadlines for applications, institution-specific scholarships and financial aid. You need to have your ACT or SAT (if required) completed in time to apply. Once you apply, you need to ensure your transcript and ACT or SAT scores are sent to the institution.

Dual Enrollment

Eligible juniors and seniors can take courses through the SD universities or technical colleges. WDT courses are free and University courses are at a reduced cost from regular tuition (approximately \$150 plus books). Dual enrollment opens November 1 for Spring 2023. You get college and high school credit for these courses, and some courses can count toward required graduation requirements. Students can also take technical courses for dual enrollment. See your School Counselor for more information.

Important December 15 deadline information for WDT Dual Enrollment:

- For WDT courses taught at Stevens, students must be fully registered by December 15 or they will be dropped from the course at Stevens. They could still take the course at WDT or online through WDT.

- To get FREE textbooks/materials for WDT courses students must be fully registered with WDT by December 15. After December 15, students will be required to purchase their own textbook/materials.

There will be application assistance for students taking WDT classes at SHS next semester on Wednesday, November 30 and Thursday, December 1 in the Freshman lunchroom at 7:30 am.
