

Dual Enrollment with the BOR:**Eligibility requirements:****High school Juniors must meet one of the following requirements:**

- a. Earn an ACT composite score of 24 or
- b. Rank in the upper one third of their graduating class or
- c. Earn a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.5 on a 4.0 scale

High school seniors must meet one of the following requirements:

- a. Earn an ACT composite score of 21 or
- b. Rank in the upper one-half of their graduation class or
- c. Earn a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.25 on a 4.0 scale

Placement into Composition-English 101: (Must meet one of the following)

- a. ACT English score of 18 or
- b. Smarter Balance ELA score of 2583 or
- c. Writing Accuplacer score of at least 263

Placement into College Algebra-Math 114: (Must meet one of the following)

- a. Math index of 1150
Math Index (MI) = 250xHS.GPA + 17xMathACT
- b. Smarter Balance Math score of 2628 or
- c. Math Accuplacer score of 250-300.

Dual Enrollment with WDT:**Eligibility requirements: None****Placement into Composition-English 101: Same as BOR****Placement into College Algebra-Math 114 (Must meet one of the following)**

- a. Math ACT score of 20
- b. Smarter Balance Math score of 26288 or higher
- c. Math Accuplacer score of 250-300

WDT classes guaranteed to transfer to BOR: ENGL 101, SPCM 101, ECON 202, PSYC 101, SOC 100, SOC 201, MATH 114, CHEM 106

Students may take CTE courses at WDT for Academy requirements or elective credit.

Students may take Math & Science to meet those HS requirements or for elective credit.

Students may take US History; * History 152 it will cover EITHER 2 OR 3 of US History and is not an option as a Social Science elective if you have taken AP US History (See your counselor if you plan to take college US History).

Students may take other courses for elective credit.

Students may take any Dual Credit offering; many BOR universities and WDT offer more courses than are listed on the reverse side.

WDT has a lot of technical courses that are available for Dual Credit.

Withdrawing/Failing: If a student Fails, Withdraws or is dropped by the institution for non-engagement, the student becomes ineligible to take another Dual Enrollment course UNTIL they meet one of the following criteria: 1) They petition based on an extenuating circumstances and it's approved 2) They take the same course and pay the full HSDC rate of \$145/credit hour and successfully pass the course or 3) They have taken additional Dual Credit courses and have an overall HSDC GPA of a 2.5. *Recommended to contact the college to determine eligibility moving forward before guiding student on withdrawing from a course.
