Dual Credit Summer and Fall 2023

- Registration for summer Dual Credit is open for the BOR and WDT. Current juniors are eligible to take dual credit in the summer.
- April 1: Dual Credit registration opens for fall 2023 for the BOR and WDT.
- April 18 & 19: Dual Credit registration assistance at 7:40 am in the freshman lunchroom. Assistance will be provided for the BOR and the WDT registration application. The SHS school counselors and representatives from the BOR and WDT will be there to assist students.
- Dual Credit courses cost \$48.33 per credit (roughly \$150 per course) through the BOR and WDT.

Honors Convocation for Seniors

Honors convocation will be held on Tuesday, May 16 at 7:00 pm in the main gym. Seniors who are graduating with honors and/or have been offered scholarships will be recognized. Students will be asked to fill out a scholarship form (which will be mailed home in April and handed out in English courses). The form can also be downloaded on the website Stevensraiders.com (hover over “Other Information” located at the top of the page and find “Honors Convocation”). All scholarships to be offered must be submitted to Brandy Bedford in Student Services by April 24 at 4:00 pm. Seniors taking classes through these programs must meet the grading deadlines for off-campus courses (as listed below) in order to participate in the graduation ceremony.

SDVHS-An official grade report must be received by the SHS Registrar by noon on Friday, May 19.

Dual Enrollment-Students must report their grade(s) to Student Services by noon Thursday, May 25.

Credit Recovery-Courses must be complete by noon on Friday, May 26.
