11th & 12th Grade: Post-High Presentations

- Senior Presentations: Sept 21 during Senior English Classes
- Junior Presentations: Sept 27 during Junior English Classes

The School Counselors will present post-high information to all juniors and seniors currently enrolled in junior and senior level English classes. English classes will come to the library for these presentations. This is a GRADtime 12 requirement for seniors. Seniors without a current English class should attend during an open period (no presentations period 4 or 5; a make up lesson is available on Canvas). The counselors will share information on GradTime 12 requirements, career exploration, academic preparation for college and career goals, financial aid and scholarship opportunities, as well as choosing and applying to college. We encourage students to work with their counselor so we can assist them in planning their future college and career goals.


