 - City staff will help you place your order. Items may include groceries, toiletries, cleaning supplies, and other household necessities. Books and audio-video resources from the Library can also be included.
 - A volunteer or staff member will fill your order (if items are available) at a local store and will deliver the order free of charge to your residence. The participant will need to pay for the items with cash or check when the delivery is made. There is a \$50.00 limit on grocery orders, however, participants can order as many times during the week as needed. (within City Limits)
- All deliveries will be finished by 5:00 on Fridays. Deliveries will not be made over the weekend.

One Spirit

- In response to the current Nationwide emergency, we will, as much as possible, provide
 the resources the Lakota people will need to contain the spread of the virus among their
 people.
- We of One Spirit are doing all we can to not only continue our normal food, firewood, and community support to the Rez, we are also spending our reserves to supplement our ability to help the Lakota help themselves. We are paying the Buffalo House employees to process elk and buffalo provided by the tribe. The meat will be distributed to all 9 districts of the Reservation.
- Extra food is being brought in from Feeding South Dakota and we are working with the tribe to arrange for safe distribution.
- Supplies are still going to the Allen Youth/Community Center, the Bear Cave suicide prevention program, Goldie's Meals on Wheels feeding the homeless of Pine Ridge, the Manderson Feeding Program, the Rosebud Soup Kitchen, and more.

- For now, we will be stocking non-perishables like canned vegetables, cereal, peanut butter, pasta, rice, etc.
- Food will be delivered to the people who live in Pine Ridge to prevent crowds of people from coming to the food distribution building.
- We will continue to work with Buche Foods through the voucher program to provide the
 household supplies that everyone needs. The arrangement with Buche Foods, begun
 just before the Pandemic, to provide household supplies like cleaning agents, soap,
 personal hygiene items, and that increasingly sought-after icon of the pandemic, toilet
 paper, continues and has increased to include items needed to fight this virus.
- We are providing wood as much as possible. Unless there are urgent situations, the number of loads each family can get will be limited. We are trying to work with other organizations who have wood programs to coordinate our efforts.
- We are also asking for help to get fabric and sewing supplies to volunteers who are making face masks and the like.
