Goal 3: Behavioral

In 2023 through a student survey and observable factors, 56.3% said that people care about each other in my class. In 2024, we want 80% of students to feel that people care about each other in my class. (peer relationships)

In 2023, 92% said that my teacher cares about me. In 2024, we want 95% of students to feel that my teacher cares about me.(adult relationships)

Strategies:

- **1:** Students will receive explicit instruction and visuals on routines and procedures.
- **2:** Students will receive explicit instruction on social emotional skills. For example conflict resolution, assertive voice, self regulation, noticing, safe place, safe keeper, and brain states.
- **3:** Students will receive whole school relationship building through assemblies, buddies, shared lunches/recesses.
- **4:** Clear student and teacher expectations created, modeled, and revised often.
